What do we need to take care a tree?

- You need to water the new tree once a day over the first two weeks.
- The young tree needs about 20 gallons of water over the first three years.
- Mulch helps keep moisture and decomposes materials to enrich the soil.
- Prune the trees to cut down the dead branches. Pruning is important because it removes dead, damaged and diseased branches to help prevent insect and decay organisms from entering the tree.
